Rob Stewart called this morning.

He said that he is taking James Lockyer off his case, and mentioned various letters going out to law society. I told Stewart to write to James with his concerns and Stewart said that he is telling me now on the phone that he is taking James off his case.

Stewart is upset with Susan Mulligan as well, because he says she didn't bring up at trial that Heather Lamarche (the officer in charge of the case) is behind everything.

I repeated, and Stewart seemed to agree, that I am familiar with the "newspaper analysis" that is important to Stewart's case. Stewart was upset that James wasn't familiar with the newspaper analysis.

Stewart doesn't want to see us. (I hadn't offered to come see him).

He thinks that Susan Mulligan has "screwed" him, and with reference to Susan Mulligan, said something about "love and hate is so close". Stewart feels he's been screwed by every lawyer who has ever worked on this case and "has it down on paper". He said he can't understand why James isn't familiar with his case by now.

He wanted to know that I would pass this along to James. I said I would tell James what he told me.
